

## **ADDITIONAL ZOMBIE INFO**

**Life-flags:** Humans will be wearing a flag football-type belt around their waist. Zombies will attempt to snatch flags from the humans. Please review [“Zombie” Specific Rules](#) prior to race-day.

**Zombie Zones:** Zombies will be placed along the course in zones. Each zombie must remain in his or her assigned zone throughout the race. If a zombie wants to be in a zone with a friend or if a participant 13 years or under is signing up to be a zombie, please email us at [zombierun@runwildmissoula.org](mailto:zombierun@runwildmissoula.org) as soon as possible. If it is a parent or guardian/child entry situation, please specify this by putting "Parent or Guardian/Child Zombie Zone Entry" in the subject line to ensure you will be in the same zone on race day. All other requests will be honored on a first come, first served basis with zone availability in mind.

**Attire and Costume:** Zombies must provide his or her own zombie costume. (i.e. take some old clothes, tear them up, splatter them with fake blood and/or green ooze, paste leaves on them, rub with dirt, etc. Have fun with it!) Costumes should be distinguishable as a zombie. There will be prizes for the best, scariest, and funniest costumes. No props, weapons, or mock weapons are allowed.

**Zombie Makeup and Pre-race Instruction:** On race day, zombies must arrive at Fort Missoula between 9:30 a.m. and 12:05 p.m. for makeup application and zombie zone assignment. Makeup is applied on a first-come, first served basis; the earlier you arrive, the better your makeup. If you are doing your own makeup application, you must still be at Fort Missoula prior to 12:05 p.m. for instruction and zone assignment.
