But at this time, we will step away and let the Snow Joke continue without RWM involvement. We plan to focus on our hub of community events that promote our mission and support our core values.

On behalf of RWM, we wish the Snow Joke and all those affiliated and running to enjoy the long, amazing tradition that has been established. Perhaps I'll see you up there... it's been a long time since I ran 13.1 miles... uphill... in the snow!
